- Kindergarten
 - French Kindergarten registration now closed
 - 74 applicants for french immersion (30+ waitlist; very surprising)
 - Next Week English Kindergarten opens up
 - South Park is no longer a district-wide catchment which may be why we are seeing an increase in numbers
- Staffing
 - o SJD has had some staffing instability within our classrooms which has been challenging
