## 9. Open floor for parent/member comments & new ideas - 7:45 pm

- COVID update: Information sharing, tracking, questions
  - Today was the first day all but 1 staff member (including teachers and EAs) was missing
  - Office has been healthy
  - Student illness rate peaked at 38 approximately 1.5 weeks ago; previously at the 20-30 mark; now below 30
- School Supplies
  - How did it go?
    - Very positive feedback from teachers
    - High parent participation (>80%); no complaints
    - Money pooled and used to refurbish supplies for the class
    - Since December 2022, there was still money available
    - Heavy lift for secretary staff; Murray to complete for the 2022/23 school year
